



SPOTLIGHT ON – MANDALAY BAY RESORT AND CASINO

The AAA Four Diamond award-winning Mandalay Bay is a lush, tropical destination with award-winning restaurants, world-class entertainment, a white sand beach and a dynamic convention center. The 120-acre resort delivers a comprehensive resort experience to the Las Vegas Strip providing guests with a wide range of best-in-class experiences within a sheltering oasis. Mandalay Bay will serve as the host hotel for

The feeling of a vibrant paradise begins in Mandalay Bay's registration lobby where visitors will find a 14-foot-high, saltwater aquarium reminiscent of the beautiful coral reefs of the South Pacific. The impressive 13,000-gallon exhibit is filled with dozens of aquatic species including two leopard sharks and a variety of colorful Angelfish.

Steps away from the excitement of Mandalay Bay, the all-suite Delano Las Vegas will soon deliver a dynamic energy and playful atmosphere when it transports the iconic Delano brand from the shores of South Beach to the Las Vegas Strip in Fall 2014. Also, Mandalay Bay is home to the newly renovated

424-room Four Seasons Hotel Las Vegas, located on the 35th through 39th floors, featuring a separate entrance, lobby, check in and hotel services, including two restaurants, a spa and a private pool.

Celebrity chef restaurants shine at Mandalay Bay including Charlie Palmer's Aureole; Fleur by Hubert Keller; STRIPSTEAK, a Michael Mina Restaurant; Rick Moonen's rm seafood and RX Boiler Room; Wolfgang Puck's Trattoria del Lupo; Border Grill by chefs Mary Sue Milliken and Susan Feniger as well as KUMI Japanese Restaurant and Bar by Akira Back. Also, Charlie Palmer Steak can be found within Four Seasons; and Hussong's Cantina, the Mexican landmark's first outpost, Rí Rá Irish Pub and Hubert Keller's Burger Bar can be found at The Shoppes at Mandalay Place.

Mandalay Bay Events Center, a 12,000-seat entertainment, sporting and special event venue, hosts world-class concerts, UFC events and award shows and can be used for large conferences, too. *Michael Jackson ONE* by *Cirque du Soleil* is a sonic, tonic fusion of acrobatics, dance and visuals that takes the audience on an immersive journey through the music and spirit of Michael Jackson. Within the theatre's foyer, groups can host an exclusive culinary event along with an artist meet-and-greet prior to the performance. The House of Blues Concert Hall, an intimate 1,800-seat venue, features live music from the likes of the legendary Carlos Santana, among others.

Nearby, DAYLIGHT Beach Club transports guests from the hustle and bustle of The Strip to an upscale and chic tropical oasis.

The chic, fashion-forward 38,000-square-foot venue features state-of-the-art production, theatrics and world-renowned DJs who refine a "night out," creating unique and memorable events each evening.

The award-winning, three-level Mandalay Bay Convention Center, a leader in sustainability and green meeting options, is truly a facility for every function, offering 1.7 million square feet of flexible meeting and exhibit space. Recently announced, Mandalay Bay will expand the Convention Center with the addition of more than 350,000 square feet of exhibit space by January 2016. Currently, the Convention Center offers four pillarless ballrooms, ranging from 10,000 to 100,000 square feet, with the largest space – the Mandalay Bay Ballroom – that can accommodate a meeting for up to 8,500 attendees or dinner for more than 6,000 guests. Break-out space can be divided to accommodate more than 75 simultaneous meetings, while the facility's state-of-the-art technology allows for the most advanced presentations.

Consider one of the unique variety of venues including the famous sand-and-surf Mandalay Bay Beach, the AZA-accredited, predator-based Shark Reef Aquarium or a lounge made completely of ice.
